Featured Wine: Kuhlken Vineyards Field Blend 2023

As you know Kuhlken Vineyards has recently undergone replanting, indicating a significant investment in rejuvenating the vineyard. We are finally starting to see some fruit come in. The Kuhlken Vineyards Field Blend 2023 is our first wine from Kuhlken Vineyards since 2018. Producing only 59 cases worth of the wine, we were happy to create and celebrate this wine on its

Making this wine was an absolute delight! We co-fermented the Grenache, Petite Sirah and then added the Sangiovese in whole clusters. The Mourvèdre was fermented separately under carbonic maceration before being blended back together and aged for just a few months.

The Kuhlken Vineyards Field Blend 2023 is crafted to be a delightful celebration in a bottle. With its playful and fruity profile, it's meant to be savored in the moment, bringing joy and conviviality to any occasion. Pour a glass, raise a toast and relish the vibrant flavors that dance on your palate.

You may wonder why we opted against a longer aging process, more typical of our esteemed Kuhlken Vineyards Reserves. The answer lies in the unique characteristics of this particular vintage and the stage of development of our vineyard.

The vines at Kuhlken Vineyards are still in their youth following our replanting. As such, they haven't yet reached maturity to yield grapes suitable for the extended aging required for a bolder style of wine.

It's a wine that encourages enjoyment and camaraderie, perfect for sharing laughter and creating memories with friends and loved ones. So let's raise our glasses and celebrate the journey of Kuhlken Vineyards, one sip at a time!

Wines Featured in April Wine Club



2023 Trebbiano

100% Trebbiano

On the nose, you'll find hints of tangerine, white flowers, wet stone and green apple. All of these follow through on the palate and finishes with subtle almond. This is a medium-bodied white wine with a long finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2022 Arcadia

62% Niagara, 26% Roussanne, 7% Riesling, 5% Viognier

With notes of lemon, buttered toast, hay, white flowers and honeydew melon, this medium-bodied wine has a bright acidity and low levels of tannin, it's a complex and fun drinking wine.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2022 Texas Over the Moon Rosè

45% Cinsault, 29% Grenache, 26% Mourvèdre

The nose on our rosé is elegant and aromatic. You'll experience notes of apricot, white flowers and rose petal, lychee, red apples and stone. This light to medium-bodied rosé is smooth and easy drinking on the palate with a pleasant and balanced acidity.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2021 Texas High Plains Grenache

88% Grenache, 12% Alicante Bouschet

Our 2021 Grenache has lovely red fruit notes of cranberries and strawberries. In addition, there's bramble, rose petal, cracked white pepper with some herbs found on the palate as well as the nose. This wine is fuller-bodied with fine and velvety tannins on a long finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2037

2021 Texas Mourvèdre

82% Mourvèdre, 12% Carignan, 6% Syrah

A complex wine, this vintage has notes of kirsch, black cherries, red currant jam, earth, blueberries, tomato leaf and roses. The palate is smooth with medium-minus tannins and hints of cocoa on the finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2029

2020 Valhalla

70% Montepulciano, 13% Dolcetto, 12% Tempranillo, 5% Petite Sirah

The Valhalla is always a non-traditional Italian-style blend and this vintage is no different. We've added a dash of Tempranillo and Petit Sirah to the base for structure and tannin. Montepulciano is a grape happy to be blended and we really enjoy working with it.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2035

2019 Newseaux

28% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Merlot, 14% Carignan, 14% Petite Sirah, 9% Malbec, 7% Tempranillo

Newseaux is fairly aromatic with notes of black cherry, black and red currants, cocoa and hints of game. This medium-bodied wine has cherry, hints of cranberry and eucalyptus on the palate with lots of cocoa powder on the finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2030
