To secure your allocation of this limited release wine, you are invited to join The Collector's Club by pre-purchasing the current vintage in barrel. With each allocation pre-purchase, you then have access to buy limited quantities of back vintages of Kuhlken-Österberg in bottle. Once you pre-purchase an allocation for this year's vintage of Kuhlken-Österberg, you will automatically be allocated for future vintages of the Kuhlken-Österberg wines.

Each year, we will unveil a new vintage at the Kuhlken-Österberg Release Party. This event is an opportunity for existing members to pick up pre-purchased allocations. This Release Party could also feature tastings of previous vintages and the new future allocation.



#### Collector's Label Story:

For years Julie Kuhlken has wanted to design an all black label for the KO series, and then 2020 came around to provide the perfect year to do so. Not only did is mark the onset of the COVID epidemic and lockdowns that closed the tasting room for months, it was also one of the most challenging vintages in years in Texas. Due to an early fall freeze in 2019, dubbed the "Halloween Massacre," vines suffered severe damage to their 2020 buds. Very few whites wines could be produced in 2020, and of the reds only a significantly reduced yield could be harvested. The good news is that the lower cropping allowed the vines to concentrate all of their energy and produce excellent and intense fruit.
