Our Newest Texas High Plains White Wine Blend

Niagara

Niagara is actually a cold-hardy hybrid that is popular in North America and originated in Niagara County, New York in 1868. We sourced the grapes from Crossnoe Vineyards.

Roussanne

Roussanne is a traditional Rhône varietal often used in blends with Viognier to add acidity and finesse.

These grapes were sourced from Lahey Vineyards.

Riesling

Riesling, of course, is a cold weather vinifera that is very popular in Germany, Austria and Alsace as well as Australia. While it may seem improbable in Texas, we were curious enough to give it a try and are pleasantly surprised with the results!

These grapes were sourced from Crossnoe Vineyards.

Viognier

Viognier is a white Rhône variety that was likely brought to France from present-day Croatia by the Romans. Viognier's powerful aromas of peaches, apricots and violets make it one of the world's most recognizable grape varieties. We sourced the grapes from Rowland Taylor Vineyards.

2022 Texas High Plains Trebbiano

100% Trebbiano

This is our first vintage of Trebbiano, with a portion of it fermented in a concrete egg. On the nose, you will find notes of golden delicious apple, white flowers, brioche, wool, lemon, lime and buttered toast. The palate is smooth and fairly creamy with a lingering soft finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2022 Arcadia

62% Niagara, 26% Roussame, 7% Riesling, 5% Viognier
On the nose, you'll find notes of lemon, buttered toast, hay, white flowers and honeydew melon. This medium-bodied wine has a bright acidity and low levels of tannins, making it a complex and fun wine to experience.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2021 Viognier Reserve

100% Viognier

This wine has lots of tropical notes such as candied pineapple and kiwi, golden delicious apple, pear and hints of brioche. This medium-bodied wine has a smooth mouthfeel and finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2024

I want to say thank you from not just Julie and me, but from the whole Pedernales Cellars team for being part of our Wine Club. It wouldn't be possible to bring authentic and serious Texas wine to the world if it weren't for y'all and we appreciate you deeply. This is our first Summer Sippin' white wine package and we are very happy that you decided to opt-in. We are very excited to release the first vintage of Arcadia, a blend based on the Niagara grape.

Of course, as we get to the end of the summer, it is exciting to start talking about a new vintage and a harvest season that is starting to ramp up. 2023 is special because we have made so much progress at Kuhlken Vineyards with Evan, our vineyard manager and the team getting all of the new vines established and having a few blocks that should bring us our first taste of estate grown vines in several years.

With our long term partners in the Hill Country and High Plains we are excited about a vintage that promises to bring some of the most complete and balanced fruit we have seen in years. Places like Desert Willow, now in their 2nd year of transitional organic growing, will produce some amazing Mourvèdre and Grenache, along with newer plantings of Syrah and Alicante Bouschet. Meanwhile, you might expect to see some favorites like Vermentino back in the program with the vintage progressing beautifully at Canted County Vineyards. We know many of these are months or years from release, but the journey of bringing this vintage to the bottle is something we want to share with you, and you will be the first to experience these wines when it is time for them to be opened.

Of course, this summer you'll experience our current releases and we hope you'll really enjoy them. Our part in growing the grapes and crafting these wines is done. Now it is your turn to make them part of your story. Make a family gathering even better, share them with a new friend or just discover your own perfect pairing with a home-cooked meal.
