2023 Kuhlken Vineyards Field Blend 6 🕅

55% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 18% Petite Sirah, 7% Sangiovese

The nose on this wine is rich with blackberries, black cherries, cranberries and hints of bubblegum, violets and chocolate. It's a medium-bodied wine with medium tannins, a juicy mouthfeel and long finish. This wine is unfined and minimally filtered so sediment is possible.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2029

2023 Texas High Plains Vermentino ③ 🌀 🕎

77% Vermentino, 20% Roussanne, 3% Viognier

This wine has a lovely nose of lemongrass, white peach, pear, tangerine with a hint of minerality and sea breeze. There's a slight creaminess to the palate with notes of peaches, blood orange and seashells. A smooth mouthfeel is complemented by lively acidity on this medium-bodied white.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2028

2021 Aletheia (3) (3) (6) (6) (7)

50% Syrah, 25% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre

This medium-bodied wine has black fruit, fresh cracked black pepper and hints of cocoa on the nose and palette. The tannins and length make this a pleasant everyday wine.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2027

2021 Texas Mourvèdre ③ 🚯 🔞 🔗

82% Mourvèdre, 12% Carignan, 6% Syrah

This complex wine has a nose of kirsch, black cherries, red currant jam, earth, blueberries, tomato leaf and roses. The palate is smooth with medium-minus tannins and hints of cocoa on the finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2029

2021 Texas GSM Mélange 🚯 👩 🕅

40% Mourvèdre, 33% Grenache, 27% Syrah

The 2021 GSM has notes of dried herbs, black cherries, strawberries, fig and game. This fuller bodied wine has a smooth mouthfeel and long finish with soft, dusty tannins.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2032

2020 Canted County Tempranillo Reserva 🚯 🌀 🕅

76% Tempranillo, 19% Grenache, 6% Petit Verdot

This wine has intensely rich, ripe fruit notes. Blackberry, black cherry, black currant, red cherry, and raspberry mingle with chocolate notes and hints of tobacco. This full-bodied Tempranillo is juicy on the palate with plentiful tannins.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2037

2019 Lahey Vineyards Syrah 🔗

100% Syrah

This wine has a fairly pronounced nose with blackberries, bramble, smoke and eucalyptus. The juicy palate matches the nose with notes of dark fruit including plum, and a bit of minerality. This medium-bodied wine has smooth tannins and a lovely finish.
